Ida Hedwig Michels, age 94, of Wibaux, Montana passed away on Wednesday, October 25, 2006 at Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. Visitation will be from 9:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M., Monday, October 30, 2006 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach, North Dakota. Ida was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach, St. John's Altar Society, and the American Legion Auxiliary. Ida was preceded in the death by her parents; her husband, Benjamin Michels and several sisters and brothers.
