



## Ima Raisler

December 21, 1915 - July 23, 2008

Ima Raisler, 92, of Beach, North Dakota, died July 19, 2008 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson. Visitation will be on Tuesday, July 22, 2008 from 9:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, July 23, 2008 at the United Community Church of Beach with Pastor Warren Maxted officiating. Interment will be in the Beach Cemetery. Following her graduation from college, Ima taught rural schools in Morton County, south of Mandan, North Dakota. She married Elmer Raisler on September 13, 1939. She and her husband operated a family farm 10 ½ miles southeast of Beach in the Rocky Butte community. They moved into Beach in 1948 where Ima worked as a substitute teacher for Lincoln Elementary School for many years. She and her husband continued to operate the farm until their retirement in 1974. Ima had been a member of the Order of Eastern Star and had served as Worthy Matron in 1947. She was also a member of the Dickinson Elks Lodge #1137 Does. She always enjoyed playing Bridge and had traveled extensively with her husband and family. Ima was preceded in death by her

husband in 2002, one brother, Maurice Young, one sister, Jewel Doughty and special friends; Clara "Chubby" Madison and Sybil Rice.
