We lost a wonderful, brave, strong and beautiful mother, wife, grandmother, great grandmother, daughter, sister and friend on July 15, 2020. Inez Parker passed away at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. She was 85 years old. A Private Family Funeral Service will be held with Father Silvester Anthonysami officiating. Inez was born on July 23, 1934 in Wibaux County, the eighth of ten children of John Joseph and Lucille (Tarbell) Weyer of Wibaux. Inez grew up on the family farm and graduated with the class of 1952. Our mom was a very hard worker, whether at home gardening, sewing, canning or in her many years she spent as the Support Services Supervisor at the Wibaux County Nursing Home. Mom enjoyed, so much, her grandkids. They always managed to get a giggle out of her and, for us kids, that was the best sound ever! Some of our favorite memories growing up was the smell of mom's fried chicken on Sundays, her made from scratch maple bars, and warm cookies from the oven after school.

Inez was preceded in death by her parents, John Joseph and Lucille; her

brothers, Victor, Elmer, Sylvester, Floyd, Loraine, Bobbie and Raymond; her sister, Lillian also passed away at age 85, in 2016, and son-in-law, Ole Radke.
