Irma Delores Schieffer, age 90 of Wibaux Montana passed away July 20, 2021 after a short stay in the Wibaux County Nursing Home.

Visitation will be held on Sunday, July 25, 2021, from 4:00pm until 6:00pm at Silha Funeral Home in Wibaux. A Life Tribute Service will take place on Monday, July 26, 2021, at 10:00am at the Silha Funeral Home in Wibaux, with Celebrant Heidi Carney officiating. Interment will follow in the Wibaux Cemetery. She was born on September 19, 1930 in Sentinel Butte ND to Henry and Nell (Will) Franzen.

She received her education through the 6th grade at Sentinel Butte Grade School, 7th grade at the Bonnieview country school and 8th grade at Beach ND.

She rode colts for Burns Abernathy, worked for Paul Tempke, Dr. Bush at the Beach hospital, Beach hospital cafeteria and Doerner's Café before the age of 16.

She met the love of her life Anthony (Tony) Linus Schieffer in Beach ND summer of 1946. They were married in Beach ND on September 9, 1947.

They moved to Wibaux and lived in town until a year later they moved out to the W Bar Ranch north of Wibaux.

To this union, three daughters and one son were born.

Tony and Irma used to play cards with the neighbors. She farmed and

ranching alongside of Tony haying and chasing cows. She recalls driving the old pickup, holding onto the kids and Tony on top of the stock rack, trying to rope a cow, which he caught, but she stopped and there went Tony off the stock rack, down on the pickup to the ground holding onto the rope. Needless to say he was not happy but they laughed about it later. Tony passed away on their 41st wedding anniversary September 9, 1988.

Her passions were her children and grandchildren. She liked taking trips to go visit Kelly and family when they lived in MN and they took her to a Twins baseball game and a Vikings football game which she enjoyed. She was a big fan and loved watching Wibaux Longhorn sports over the years.

She loved to crochet. She made beautiful doilies, baskets, Christmas decorations, angels and she loved to enter her crocheted items in the Wibaux County Fair.

She was a fantastic cook. Just ask anyone. She made the best fried chicken and potato salad. She only used a cookbook for desserts, other than that it's a pinch of this, a little bit of that, and salt and pepper to taste. If she had a quarter for every cookie she made, she would be a millionaire. She baked every week.

She loved to garden but was always fighting the deer and rabbits to see who got there first. She made the best pickles and loved to share her tomatoes with friends and neighbors.

No matter where she went, you would find her looking at rocks. She loved looking for pretty rocks, pick them up, put them in her pocket and take them home. She was also a weed pulling machine!
