December 18, 1940 - May 26, 2025

Irvin Michael Bares, Age 84, of Beach ND passed away at 7:15 am on Monday, May 26, 2025, at Sanford Medical Center in Bismarck, ND. He was surrounded by his children at the time of his death.

Irvin was born to Frank and Marcella(Sally) Bares on December 18, 1940. He was the fifth child of 12. Irvin grew up on a family farm, 5 miles east of Beach. He attended primary school in Beach, ND and graduated high school in 1959. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in teaching from North Dakota State University in 1963. Following graduation, Irvin put his degree to use as a Vocational Agriculture instructor in Elgin, ND.

Irvin married his childhood sweetheart, Virginia Wehrman, on August 20, 1966. In 1967, Irvin and Virginia returned to Beach to take over the family farm. It was there that they lived out their lives. Despite the ever-changing nature of agriculture, Irvin had a profound love for the profession. Like so many of his friends and neighbors, he strived to be a steward of the land. It is of no surprise that he remained on the farm until his death.

Throughout his life, Irvin was an active public servant. In addition to his family and farming responsibilities, he shared his time in various civic roles for the betterment of the community and his profession. He was involved in the Jaycees, GVC Soil Conservation District, GVC Fair Board, ND Barley Council, Township Committee Board, and the Montana/ND Wool Growers. He also served as an elected county commissioner for 15 years.

Irvin was a devout Christian in the Roman Catholic Church. He was a member

of St. John the Baptist Church in Beach, ND for many years. He was active in the church and served as a Eucharistic minister. He was also an active member of the Knights of Columbus. Irvin's faith was an important part of his life and molded many of his family's traditions and cherished memories.

Irvin was preceded in death by his wife Virginia; parents Frank and Marcella; siblings Helen Fischer, Bob Bares, Jean Schulte, and Genevieve Bares; and brothers-in-law Dan Skorheim and Erv Emter.
