GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Joseph Judd Walker, age 96, passed away on Sunday, August 23, 2009 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Thursday, August 27, 2009 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral Services will be at 2:00 P.M. on Friday, August 28, 2009 at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Glendive with Brother Guy Pontoriero officiating. Interment will follow in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Judd was born the oldest of six children, on February 8, 1913 in Glendive, the son of Perry Austin and Anna Mae (Johnson) Walker. He attended Bloomfield School and Washington School in Glendive, graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1932. Judd married Lillian Raisl in Glendive on September 15, 1939. Their marriage was 24 days short of 70 years at the time of Judd's passing. Four children were born into the Walker family; Ilene, Don, Carol and Judy. In addition to Judd's farming and ranching in the Bloomfield area, he served as a director of the McCone Electric Co-op for 41 years as well as the Montana State REA Board. He also served on the Board of Directors for the Montana Rural Area Development Committee. During the years he served on these boards, he frequently attended national meetings throughout the United States. Hunting and fishing were high on his list of fun things to do. He also loved to read, including a wide variety of subjects. Most of all he loved visiting with his

friends and strangers whom he met along the way. He inherited his love of teasing people from his dad. When you were around him you always had to be on guard, as you never knew what he might pull on you. He lovingly was able to pass that trait down to some of his children and grandchildren. Judd was a member of the First Congregational Church, the Sons of Norway and the Good Sam Club. He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Jane Beran; three brothers, Earl, Gene and Robert and one granddaughter, Dorraine Latka. Survivors include his wife Lillian; daughter, Ilene (Robin) Robins; son, Don (Jackie Monforton) Walker and daughter, Carol Overlie, all of Glendive; daughter, Judy (Stephen) Latka of Janesville, Wisconsin; thirteen grandchildren, fifteen great grandchildren; a sister, Ruth Buller of Great Falls, Montana; numerous nieces and nephews and a special friend, Bruce Jurgens.
