He was very well known for his ability to shear sheep and was proud that over his lifetime he had sheared over 700,000 head. Jim was married to Bernadine Lynch on August 2, 1946 in Beach and to this union ten children were born. Jim took very good care of his family and was liked by everyone. In his later years he would always be seen walking through town and up north helping to clean up the roads by picking up cans along the streets and highways. Jim liked to take drives in the country to see different things, he always had a huge garden that he spent many evenings with a hoe in his hands fighting the mosquitoes so the weeds didn't

get his plants. He also enjoyed reading, spending time with his family, playing cards, and walking. He went to many auction sales, not to buy things but just to look at what was there. Jim was preceded in death by his wife, Bernadine Easton; one son, Herb Easton; his parents; one grandson, Ryan Begger; two sons-in-law, Ronald Begger and Rue Cale; one daughter-in-law, Gretchen Easton and one brother, Clyde Easton.
