James Francis Fischer, age 86, of Sidney, Montana passed away on Monday, April 20, 2015 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. A Graveside Service will be at the Sidney Cemetery on Saturday, April 25, 2015 at 11:00 A.M. with Father Jim O'Neil officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

James Francis Fischer was born in Royalton, Minnesota on July 16, 1928. He worked on ranches in Montana until he joined the Navy in 1948. He served with the Naval Air Corp on two aircraft carriers, the USS Roosevelt and the USS Tarawa. He was honorably discharged in 1952.

He married Edna Moore in 1951 and settled in Sidney, Montana. They had one daughter, two adopted daughters and one son from Edna's previous marriage. Jim joined the Montana Highway Patrol as a patrolman in 1954 and was honorably retired in 1970.

In 1970 Jim married Louella Hueth. He worked at Entzel Redi-Mix, enjoying the outdoors. He later became groundskeeper for the Sidney Cemeteries, taking great pride in well kept manicured lawns. In his next retirement Jim handmade exquisite horsehair belts and bridles, a lost art that he achieved master distinction. Jim and Louella grew large vegetable gardens each year. He built unique stone imbedded wishing wells, wind mills, and pillars for yard decorations that he sold in the area.

Jim is survived by six children, stepson, John (Ingrid) Moore of Falls Church, Virginia, daughter, Bonnie (David) Eggebraaten of Missoula, Montana, adopted daughters, Monica and Lisa, stepson, Gene (Arlene) Hueth of Sidney, Montana, and stepdaughter, Karla (Ross) Yates of Minot, North Dakota; eight grandchildren including, Tavis Eggebraaten of Helena, Montana, and Janna (Jason) Kolberg of Missoula, Montana; twelve great-grandchildren; and two sisters, Leona (George) Mourood of Columbus, Ohio, and Marge Duffey of Whitehall, Montana.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife, Edna Fischer; his wife, Louella Fischer; his brothers, Edwin Fischer and Robert Fischer; and his sisters, Alvina Schipper, Louise Shroyer, and Marie Bartell.
