



## James McCauley

September 18, 1917 - February 7, 2003

James Charles McCauley, age 85, of Glendive and formerly of Logan, Montana, passed away on Sunday, January 19, 2003 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Graveside Services with military honors will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, February 7, 2003 at the Montana State Veterans Cemetery, Fort Harrison, Helena, Montana. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. James was born on September 18, 1917 in Missoula, Montana, the son of Charles Michael and Emma Elizabeth (Burks) McCauley. He was raised and educated in Missoula and graduated from Missoula High School with the class of 1935. James enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corp on December 11, 1941 and served during World War II. During his military career, he became good friends with General James Roosevelt. James was honorably discharged on November 27, 1945 with the rank of Master Technical Sergeant. He then returned to Montana where he farmed and ranched near Missoula and Corvalis. He later worked for the Plymale Ranch at Townsend for a number of years. James moved to Logan, Montana in 1987 and while living in Logan was a foster grandparent in Logan schools. James moved to the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive in November of 2002. James was a member of the Disabled Veterans of America, American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars. James was preceded in death by his parents; five sisters, Anna, Virginia and three infant sisters, two brothers, Joseph and Richard. James is survived by four sisters, Marian Gaforth of Wishram, Washington, Helena Shelden of Lander,

Wyoming, Kathryn Layne of Missoula, Montana and Charlotte Mounce of Spokane, Washington; 27 nieces and nephews.
