John Hendricks Corder, age 38 of Glendive, Montana passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. A memorial service will be held at 5:30 PM on Tuesday, January 16, 2024 at The Church in The Heights with Reverend Jeff Cahill officiating and Reverend Chris Sullivan and Reverend Terry Corder assisting. There, he played two years of football and graduated with the class of 2003. He was a part-time Youth Pastor at Bethel Baptist Church in York, South Carolina and later the Associate Pastor with an emphasis on youth and children at Hillcrest Baptist Church in Elgin, South Carolina. John was united in marriage to Jenny Marie Sullivan on June 06, 2009, at Beulah Baptist Church in Fountain Inn, South Carolina. They lived in Elgin, South Carolina for fourteen years before moving to Glendive in June of 2022. John was a church planter with the North American Mission Board, Pastor of The Church in the Heights, and worked for Youth Dynamics. John loved Jenny and anything that made her happy. He was an avid

outdoorsman with a zeal for duck hunting and trout fishing. John was an Eagle Scout and a member of the Order of the Arrow. He had an infectious smile and laugh, with a heart of gold. John enjoyed life to the fullest while meeting and getting to know people in order to share the gospel of Jesus Christ. His joy was living out his dream of serving the Lord by planting a church in Glendive, Montana.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, Dr. Owens and Gertie Corder and his maternal grandparents, Emory and Willie Hendricks. 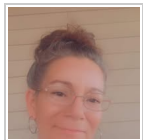

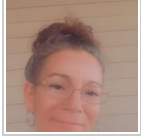
