John Peter Elvert, age 81, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, December 22, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, December 29, 2003 at the White Chapel Mennonite Church in Glendive with Pastor Neville Peterson officiating. Interment will be in the Coalridge Mennonite Cemetery in Coalridge, Montana. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. John was born on March 18, 1922 in Spencer, Nebraska, the son of Carl J. and Lillie Jane (Mathew) Elvert. John moved with his mother, sister and brother to Belltower, Montana located about 25 miles southeast of Ekalaka, when he was four years old. He attended the Reisch American School of Auctioneering in Austin, Minnesota and completed the course on March 15, 1941. John entered the U.S. Army on November 16, 1942 and served during World War II. He was honorably discharged on August 27, 1943. John was united in marriage to Ruth Marie Drawbond on July 14, 1957 in Los Angeles, California. John and his wife purchased Elvert Cabins in Glendive in March of 1968 and continued the operation of the cabins until John sold the cabins in 1998. John was preceded in death by his wife Ruth on December 22, 1997; his sister, Margaret Welson in February of 1996 and his brother, Carl Elvert in May of 1984. Survivors include many nieces and nephews including Berdena Sem and her husband Allen of Williston, North Dakota.
