John Frederick McCormick, age 67, of Lindsay, Montana, unexpectedly passed away on Wednesday, June 10, 2020 at his home in Lindsay. Visitation will be held from 12:00 P.M. until 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 17, 2020 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive, Montana. John attended 1st grade at High Point School, Lindsay, and then completed through the 8th grade at Lindsay Elementary School. John then attended and graduated from high school at DCHS of Glendive and Dawson College earning an Associate's Degree. John then transferred to MSU Bozeman, where he graduated in 1975 with a degree in Agri-Business.

John married his college sweetheart, Marla Renee Vanderwyk, in Laurel, MT on July 17, 1976. They've had a month shy of 44 wonderful years together.

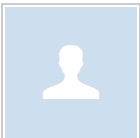
