John Miller, age 87, of Glendive, passed away on Friday, December 13, 2002 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. A Vigil service will be held at 6:30 P.M., Sunday, December 15, 2002 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, December 16, 2002 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Rite of Committal with military honors will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. John was born on July 29, 1915 near Richardton, North Dakota, the son of Peter P. and Marianna (Schmidt) Miller. He entered the Civilian Conservation Corp on June 29, 1935 at Medora, North Dakota and served until March 31, 1936. John then worked for Hogart Construction and Mobil Oil Company until June of 1937 when he started farming near Jamestown, North Dakota. John was united in marriage to Chrystal Stoddart on October 8, 1940 in Jamestown. They farmed there until 1942 when John went to Fort Snelling, Minnesota for induction into the U.S. Army. He entered active service on December 8, 1942 and received his basic training at Fort Knox, Kentucky. John was shipped overseas on June 6, 1943 and served in Africa, Sicily and Italy with the 3855 Gas Supply Company. He returned to the United States on November 27, 1945 and was honorably discharged on December 2, 1945 at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin. On January 22, 1946, John went to work for the Northern Pacific Railroad in the car department at Jamestown, North Dakota where he worked until 1962. He

was then transferred to Glendive where he worked for the railroad in the car department until his retirement in 1976. John had served as secretary for the Jamestown Moose Lodge from 1956 until 1962. He was the financial secretary of the Jamestown B.R.C. of A. James River Lodge #135 and had served as the financial secretary and recording secretary of B.R.C. of A., Hungry Joe Lodge #342 for about three years. John was preceded in death by his parents; and five brothers. Survivors include his wife, Chrystal Miller, of Glendive; one daughter, Mary Ann Hoff of Casper, Wyoming; two sisters, Rose Leiss of Dickinson, North Dakota and Margaret Braun of Redding, California; two brothers, Joe Miller of Minot, North Dakota and George Miller of Dickinson, North Dakota; two grandchildren, Michele Robson of Casper, Wyoming and Rocky Robson of Glendive; numerous nieces and nephews.
