John "Jack" W. Wyse, age 79, of Glendive, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, April 14, 2004 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Vigil service will be held at 7:30 P.M., Friday, April 16, 2004 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, April 17, 2004 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa, Father William Hogan and Father Thomas Harney officiating. Jack was born on August 7, 1924 in Savage, Montana, the son of S.D. and Emma (Mahlstedt) Wyse. In 1930, he moved with his family to Seattle, Washington where he was raised and educated. In November of 1943 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served during World War II. He was discharged in February of 1946. Jack was united in marriage to Alice Hartse on March 17, 1959 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive. While owning and operating the Montana Inn Supper Club through the 1970's and 1980's, he continued to serve the community not only with his music, but also with a great meal. Jack's love of music started with the purchase of his first guitar at the age of 11 and continued throughout the rest of his career. Jack's music touched many lives from nightclubs to weddings, anniversaries, funerals, cursillo's and cattle drives. Horses have always been an important part of Jack's life. He raised, trained, showed, judged and traded horses and mules. Jack enjoyed spending time with his

grandchildren, visiting with friends, painting, and carving. He has passed his love for music, horses and art onto his family. One of his greatest accomplishments was being inducted into the Western Swing Society in 1997. During his retirement years, cooking for and being involved in cattle drives was his passion. Jack was a devoted husband, father, grandfather and friend. He will be greatly missed. Jack was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, George; one sister, Bernie Donald; sister-in-law, Carryl Wyse and brothers-in-law, John Hanson and Dick Ford.
