



Jonathan Daniel Brosz

Jonathan “Jon” Daniel Brosz, age 43 of Bowman, North Dakota passed away on Palm Sunday, March 24, 2024 at the Southwest Healthcare Center in Bowman. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM until 7:00 PM with a Family and Friends service beginning at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, March 27, 2024 at the Bowman Lutheran Church. Funeral Services will be held at 10:00 AM on Thursday, March 28, 2024 at the Bowman Lutheran Church with Pastor Renee Johnson officiating. Interment will be in the Bowman Cemetery. Jon was born on July 11, 1980 in Mobridge, South Dakota to Dan and Jolene (Plooster) Brosz. The family moved to Bowman in 1981, where Jon was raised and educated. He was very active in high school, he was a member of the speech team, played football (Right Guard and Defensive Tackle), played basketball (Leading Rebounder) and was a member of the track team (Shot Put and Discus) and during the summers he stayed busy working on the Brooks Ranch. Jon graduated from Bowman High School with the class of 1998. Following high school he attended North Dakota State University (NDSU) in Fargo, North Dakota for one year of fun before he transferred to South Dakota School of Mines and Technology in Rapid City, South Dakota where he majored in Civil Engineering and earned his Bachelors degree in December of 2003. During college he worked summers for his father at Brosz Engineering and after his college graduation he started working full time with his father starting in January of 2004 and continued with Brosz engineering

until his passing.

During college, Jon met the love of his life, Kelsey Hurlburt and they were united in marriage on July 30, 2005 in Bowman and to this union three children were born, Kyle, Ashlynn and Megan. They have made their home in Bowman ever since.

Jon was an eighteen-year veteran with the Bowman Volunteer Fire Department, this is something that he took great pride in. He was a member of the Bowman Lutheran Church and served on the Church Council. Jon loved fishing and hunting, especially deer hunting and he has tagged several trophy whitetail bucks that he enjoyed bragging about. He was a lifelong Miami Dolphins fan and absolutely loved his time as an assistant football coach with the Bowman County Bulldogs. Above everything he truly loved his wife and kids and holidays with family, even with his sisters that he liked to harass. He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, Curtis and Phyllis Brosz; his maternal grandfather, Arlo Plooster; one aunt, Donna Brosz and two uncles, Tom Plooster and Ron Vanden Berge.
