



## Joseph "Joe" Doll Jr.

July 26, 1928 - January 6, 2003

Joseph Doll Jr., age 74, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, January 1, 2003 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Sunday, January 5, 2003 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, January 6, 2003 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. He retired in 1985 and became self employed as a meat cutter in his own butcher shop. Joe was a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Glendive Moose Lodge #949, and the Makoshika Travelers Chapter of the Good Sam Club. He enjoyed working, puttering on vehicles, fishing, ranching, and especially enjoyed spending time with his family and friends. Joe was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Reinie in January of 2001; two sons, Larry and Gary; seven sisters; four brothers and several grandchildren.
