Judith "Judi" McGlynn, age 67, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Friday, November 30, 2007, at the Roosevelt Medical Center in Culbertson, Montana, after a battle with cancer. Judi and Edward had two children, Jolene and Jonathon. The family lived in Belfield, North Dakota. On November 19, 1984, Judith married Larry McGlynn in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. Larry and Judi lived in Belfield and Culbertson, Montana, before their retirement. They retired in Beach so Judi could be close to friends and family. Judi was a hard worker. She spent many hours tending her garden and flowers. Judi cooked for many years at various cafés and enjoyed babysitting many special children wherever she lived. Judi's home was always

busy with family and friends coming and going, many of whom stopped by daily for coffee or cocktails. Judi was especially fond of her grandchildren and her nephews and nieces. Throughout all of her travels, she always ran into "someone from Sentinel Butte." Judi never knew a stranger.
