Judy was a member of the Montana Association of Cosmetology, The Glendive Women of the Moose, The Clear Creek Women's Society of Christian Service, The Clear Creek Homemakers Club and the United

Methodist Church. Cosmetology was truly her calling and she enjoyed a long career that enabled her to meet and befriend many wonderful people. She saw beauty and grace in every day events and in every person she encountered. Judy enjoyed living and traveling in California, Spain and Puerto Rico. She was present for both of her grandsons' births and some of their first memories are of her singing silly songs to them. Judy was well loved by many people for her caring heart and sincere interest in the well-being of those around her. She adored her grandsons and they were pretty sure she hung the moon!
