



Judy Diane Raisl

July 29, 1945 - November 19, 2024

Judy Diane (Buller) Raisl, age 79 of Richey, Montana, passed away on Tuesday, November 19, 2024 at the Wibaux Nursing Home, after a long battle with Alzheimer's.

Judy was the first of 6 children born to Elmer (Jim) and Caroline Buller. She grew up on the farm on Butler Table. She loved to be outside and would ride her Shetland pony Dynamite to herd cows in the ditches with her sister Bonnie. Anything outside is where she wanted to be.

She attended elementary school at the Butler Table School and then went to Richey High School where she graduated with the Class of 1963. After graduation she worked at the hospital in Sidney as a Nurses Aid for a short time and then went to work as a Teller at the bank in Circle. While working in Sidney, she met Alex (Chub) Jackson and they were married July 2, 1965. They moved to Billings and she worked for a bank there.

Due to health issues, her husband retired, bought a small hobby farm at Crane, MT and they packed up and moved. Judy then went to work at Pamida in Sidney for about 5 years. During that time, her husband Chub died.

Judy got remarried December 26, 1992 to Raymond (Butch) Raisl and they made their home in Richey, MT since. Together they both took the EMT training and became EMT's for the Richey community. Butch was the Fire Chief and Judy would man the radio while the firemen were out on calls.

Because she was always home, many residents contacted her to have their blood pressure checked and for a time she even went to the Senior Center

one day a week to do just that.

About 15 years ago she began showing signs of dementia and a few years later was diagnosed with the onset of Alzheimer's. She slowly deteriorated with her dedicated, loving and caring husband by her side until she had to be transitioned to the nursing home in August, 2024. She always knew Butch, and would visibly light up when he entered the room. She knew him until the day she passed.

Judy was preceded in death by her parents Jim and Carol Buller; mother-in-law Vera Raisl; siblings Darrel Buller, Dennis Buller and Karen Moore; brother-in-law Duane Ulrich; sisters-in-law Elaine Raisl and Betty Timp; nephews Mikel and Colin Ulrich; and niece Paulette Wengeler.

She is survived by her husband Butch; her sisters Bonnie (Larry) Smith of Richey, MT, Nancy Ulrich of Richey, MT, and Cami (Ed) Mahoney of Kodiak, AK; brother-in-laws Bill (Patti) Raisl of Glendive, MT, Bob Raisl of Richey, MT, Jim (Erika) Moore of Seattle, WA; sister-in-law Jan Buller of Richey, MT; and several nieces and nephews.

A Memorial Celebration will be held on Monday, November 25, 2024 at 2:00 PM at the Richey Senior Center in Richey with Kris Buller officiating. Private interment will be held in the Richey Cemetery in the spring of 2025. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive, Montana has been entrusted with the arrangements.
