



Julia "Judy" Marquart

February 16, 1944 - July 11, 2025

Julia "Judy" Leah Marquart, 81, of Glendive, Montana, passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones on Friday, July 11, 2025, at the Glendive Medical Center. Visitation will be held from 6-7:00 PM on Monday, July 14, 2025, with a Rosary at 7:00 PM at Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM, Tuesday, July 15, 2025, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Rite of Committal will follow at Dawson County Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with arrangements.

Judy was born on February 16, 1944, in Charter Oak, Iowa, to Vincent and Agnes (Gollhoffer) Adams. In 1954, the family made the move to Montana, where Judy would go on to complete her secondary education in Circle. In 1965, Judy met the love of her life, Larry Marquart, and the two were married a year later at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive. They made their home in Glendive and raised two children together—Lee, born in 1970, and Stacy, born in 1972.

Judy dedicated nearly 30 years of her life to the historic Jordan Hotel in Glendive, serving in a variety of roles with dedication and care. After retiring, she poured her heart into helping care for her grandchildren, a role she cherished deeply.

From 1982 to 1999, Judy and her family enjoyed countless cherished moments at their cabin at Fort Peck Lake. She found great joy in quiet pleasures—reading romance novels, nurturing the many houseplants that

filled her home, and simply spending time with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, who were the true joy of her heart.

Judy will be remembered for her warmth and her devotion to family. She leaves behind a legacy of love, laughter, and strength that will live on through those who knew her best.

She was preceded in death by her son, Lee Marquart in 2015; her parents, Agnes and Vincent Adams, Sr.; her siblings, Kathryn Schriver, Joan Groh, Vincent Adams, Jr.; and brothers-in-law, Duane Gackle and James Schriver; her son-in-law, Lyle Nilson; and niece, Jeanne Schriver.

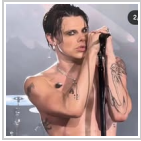
