June Victoria (Zinda) Paul, age 85, passed away on Tuesday, January 21, 2020 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. Visitation will be held from 1:00 PM until 4:00 PM on Friday, January 24, 2020 at Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 PM on Friday, January 24, 2020 at Silha Funeral Home. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, January 25, 2020 at St. John's Catholic Church with Father Dan Berg officiating. June was born on June 13, 1934 north of Wibaux to Lawrence and Elsie (Hagemann) Zinda. She lived north of Wibaux until the age of ten, when they moved into town. There she continued her education and graduated from Wibaux High School with the class of 1952. While in high school, June met her future husband, Neil Paul at the age of fifteen, became engaged at sixteen, finished school and they were married in 1953, a year after she graduated. Neil had come here from Wisconsin at the age of sixteen to work on farms as a couple of his brothers had. One of his brothers always teased that Neil went to Montana, met that redhead and never came back home. After they were married, they moved to Wisconsin for a couple of years, where Judy was born, and then eventually moved back to North Dakota and Montana where they made their permanent home. Four more children, Neil, Mike, Robert, and Ronnie were born to them after they moved back.

The couple made their permanent home north of Beach, where they continued to raise their family. Every year there was always a big garden. June raised all kinds of vegetables, canned and preserved the garden crop each year. When it would come berry picking time, she loved to pick chokecherries, so every year they would pick and she would make jam/syrup for the family. If there were wild grapes on the Yellowstone River, they would pick them and again she would make jelly. Wild plums were also on the list. Along with that, June would bake nine loaves of homemade white bread every Saturday. One year June entered a loaf in the county fair and won a ribbon on it. She was very proud of that accomplishment because she said she had some pretty good competition at the time.

When the children were a bit older, June went to work in the bakery in Beach and later the Dickinson's Store. In 1977, she started her favorite job as a custodian at Lincoln Elementary School in Beach. She loved being around all the little kids. The work was hard and demanding, but she always seemed to accomplish the task set before her. She worked there for twenty-two years and retired in 1999.

As the kids left home, Neil and June enjoyed going to the Yellowstone River camping most every weekend. It was something they both looked forward to every year. June enjoyed doing crossword puzzles, playing Scrabble and putting together jigsaw puzzles. She did some crocheting, making every grandchild a baby afghan, but her favorite time was spent cooking and baking, being Mom, and later Grandma.

June is preceded in death by her husband of forty-nine years, Neil; her parents, two sisters and her son, Neil Jr.

June is survived by her sister, Ilene (Curt) Cale of Wibaux; her daughter, Judy; her sons, Mike (Julie) and Robert all of Beach and Ronald (Liz) of Walcott, North Dakota; fifteen grandchildren; twenty-seven great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews. June will be deeply missed by everyone who knew and loved her.
