June Zody, age 98 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Thursday, July 7, 2022 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Visitation will be from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Monday, July 11, 2022 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, July 12, 2022 at the Glendive Evangelical Church with Pastor Ben Baker and Pastor David Steinbron officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive.

June Geraldine Grigsby Zody was born on June 15th, 1924 in Sioux City Iowa to Doyel and Lillian (Anderson) Grigsby. She joined her beloved husband George in Heaven on July 7th, 2022.

June was raised and educated until the 10th grade in Sioux City, along with her sister Shirley. In 1939 she made a visit to Montana, where she met George while attending church with her grandparents Frank and Kate Grigsby. After a few visits between Montana and Sioux City, George and June were married April 5th, 1941 in a small service at the South Valley Church parsonage where George's parents, Ruth and Cecil Zody, Lilian Eldridge, and Mrs. Skovie witnesses as Rev. Louis Skovie, pronounced them husband and wife. As they grew the family farm near Bloomfield, Montana, they also grew a large family of 9 children that resulted in 24 grandchildren, 61 great grandchildren, and 3 great-great grandchildren.

June accepted the Lord as her Savior in the fall of 1946. This was very important to her; family and the Lord were her Pride and Joys in Life. She had

great respect for her grandparents and their devotion to the Lord. She recalls fondly Bible studies she attended with them where everyone would kneel at the pews and pray. She would carry this devotion to her children and their children for the rest of her life. She was an active member of the South Valley Fundamental Church and later the Bloomfield Alliance Church. They stayed members for many years, even after 1985 when George and June moved to Glendive. Eventually, they would become members of the Glendive Evangelical Church where she always had a smile on her face as the pews filled up with her family all around her, and she dug deep in her purse for the Lifesavers to send down the row.

June was an avid baker and embroiderer as she was a charter member of Live and Learn Homemakers Club. She won many prizes at the Dawson County Fair over the years. Each of her children and grandchildren were gifted a pair of her hand embroidered pillow cases though out the years. Only of course, after they had been submitted to the fair for judging. She was very active in the community, church, and loved volunteering at the Attic. She was always ready to lend a helping hand to a neighboring farmer and of course feeding her children and grandkids a delicious meal anytime she could find a reason to.

June is survived by her children Linda Eaton, Steven Zody, Rhonda Bornholtz, Kathy (Bill) Lafond, Mark (Anita) Zody, Sheryl (Roy) Johnson, Valerie (Jim) Maus, and Susan (Bill) Edwards, and her many grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband George Zody; son Larry Zody; sister Shirley Peck; and a brother, Stanley Anderson.
