Karla May Bohn, age 55, of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota passed away on Monday, March 14, 2016. A Prayer Service will be held at 7:00 PM on Friday, March 18, 2016 at the Community Center in Sentinel Butte. A Memorial Service will be held at 10:00 AM on Saturday, March 19, 2016 at the Community Center in Sentinel Butte with Mick Bohn Officiating. Karla was born on March 17, 1960 in Richardton, North Dakota to Anton and Victoria (Hoff) Sattler. She was raised in Richardton and received her elementary education at St. Mary's Catholic Grade School. She graduated high school in 1978 and went on to attend college at North Dakota State University. Karla later transferred to Dickinson State University and graduated with a degree in business administration in 2006.

Karla met Timothy in 1971 and they married on June 8, 1979 in Richardton. After their marriage, they lived in Dickinson until 1982 and then moved to Sentinel Butte where she resided until her passing.

I had Bailey with me and her and The Bohn's Great Dane Scenar were going at some serious playing full force, completely destroying everything and she just laughed and was so happy they were having such a great time she didn't care. Of course she had to ask me if I was hungry and if she could get me anything like she always did. We just sat at the table for hours talking about everything and nothing all at the same time and laughing and laughing. When I left she walked me to the door and hugged me. She said she just loved when I came to visit, to please come back soon and to keep in touch with her. A couple weeks later I got a picture text of the hatched pheasants.*

*Almost always if I visited in the summer there was a vase of wild flowers that Tim had picked for her. The Bohn's were the most*

*loving and caring family, always doing things for each other. It's strange to think of ever visiting them and not having her there. Their house just felt like home because she felt like home.*

*At the funeral services yesterday, I was ease dropping on everyone's conversations before it started. I couldn't control the tears running down my face from what people had to say about her. I wasn't the only one who she made feel special. She had this gift of making everyone feel important and loved and that they mattered. I am truly thankful that I was blessed to know her. I am so grateful that all though the part I played was small, I was part of her life.*

*If everyone lived their life like Karla did, with an open mind, a big heart, kindness, compassion, smiles and laughter instead of complaints, charity and just pure simple unconditional love the world would be such a better place. She makes me want to be a better person. I honestly cannot fathom life without her.
