Kathleen "Kathy" Mae Hedrick of Billings, Montana, age 66, and formerly of Glendive, Montana passed away on Tuesday, December 31, 2013 at St. Vincent's Hospital in Billings. A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, January 4, 2014 at the White Chapel Mennonite Church in Glendive with Pastor Neville Peterson officiating. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Kathleen was born on October 26, 1947 in Glendive to Harold and Ruby (Mullet) Stanley. The family moved to Billings when she was three. Kathleen attended elementary and junior high school at Garfield and graduated from Senior High School with the class of 1965. She married Kenneth Hedrick on August 7, 1966. They had two children, David and Heide. In 1974 she and the children moved to Pennsylvania for a short time and then came to Glendive where she helped care for her grandmother, Ora Mullet, until her death in November of 1975. She and the children continued living in Glendive where she worked as a waitress at the Jordan Coffee Shop and Dining Room and then as a housekeeper at Glendive Medical Center. She also served on the board of the Dawson County Domestic Violence Program for a number of years, chairing it during the program's move from the Dawson County Courthouse to its present location. In 2004, she moved to Billings to care for her mother and be closer to her children and grandchildren. While in Billings, she worked for a number of years as a housekeeper at St. Vincent Hospital and then retired in 2009 to care for her mother full time. During her years working as a waitress and a

housekeeper, she touched the lives of many people with her humor, sensitivity and willingness to go the extra mile. She was very proud of her children and grandchildren and was known for posting their photos on her housekeeping cart and sharing new photos with anyone she saw. She enjoyed working in her yard in Glendive and in Billings. She took much pride in tending the roses her father had planted. Native Montana rocks fascinated her, and she spent many hours driving the back roads around Glendive looking for rocks. An avid high school sports fans, she cheered for many Glendive teams and later for her grandsons. Hobbies included ceramics and woodworking. Her greatest joy in life was spending time with her grandsons. Kathleen was preceded in death by her father and older brother Kenneth Stanley. She is survived by her mother, Ruby Stanley; her son, David (Alexis) Hedrick and daughter, Heide (Matt) Cole; her sister, Chloe Propp; grandsons, Connor and Cooper Cole and Aiden and Jude Hedrick; two aunts; an uncle; two nieces; two nephews; and numerous cousins.
