A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 P.M. on Friday, March 20, 2015 at the St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach. Kathy was born on March 26, 1957 in Beach to Vernon and Violet (Schaal) Walters. She was raised in Beach and educated in the Beach public schools graduating from Beach High School with the class of 1975.

After their marriage, David and Kathy lived on their farm north of Beach and later moved to New Castle, Wyoming and Greeley, Colorado. Once again, they moved to several places in the Midwest until finally moving back to Beach to be near family in 2000, and then back out to the farm where she resided until the time of her passing.

Kathy was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church and was Director of Religious Education. She worked with Search and was very active in

Cursillo. Kathy also volunteered in Medora for the Medora Historical Society and worked as a volunteer at the Interpretive Center.

Kathy was more of a caregiver, always looking after others rather than herself. She especially took joy in caring for her grandmother and other elderly ladies. Her grandchildren were the light of her life. Kathy was a caring and nurturing daughter, wife, mother and grandmother and will be greatly missed.

Kathy was preceded in death by her daughter, Donna; her parents, Vernon and Viola and her grandmother Ella Schaal.
