



## Kathryn Alene ( Wyse) Haggerty

February 2, 1918 - November 6, 2010

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Kathryn Alene Haggerty, age 92 , passed away Tuesday, November 2, 2010 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Unit in Glendive. Visitation will be from 12:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. Friday, November 5, 2010 at Silvernale - Silha Funeral Home of Glendive. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 PM on Friday, November 5, 2010 at the Chapel of Silvernale - Silha Funeral Home of Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 2:00 PM on Saturday, November 6, 2010 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Rite of Committal will be held in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale - Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Kathryn was born on February 2, 1918 in Glendive, Montana, the daughter of Joseph and Jannet (Whyte) Wyse. She was the first born of her family in Montana, but was very proud that she was a descendant of Lord & Lady Whyte of Scotland. Kathryn attended Spring Valley and High Point Grade Schools in Rural Lindsay, Montana, from 1924 to 1932. She also attended Dawson County High School in Glendive from 1932 to 1936. Kathryn married George E. Haggerty on October 4, 1937 in Circle, Montana. She and her husband spent the first year of marriage in Indiana. They returned to Montana to Mink, Montana where they worked for the Joe Wyse Ranch. They purchased a farm eight miles west of Lindsay in 1943 which they continued to operate until 1969 when they moved to Glendive. Kathryn and George rented their farm in Lindsay to

neighbors when they moved to Glendive. Their nephews Mike, Jim, and Tim Wyse purchased the farm in 1990. Kathryn had been a resident at the Grandview Retirement Apartments in Glendive for five years prior to moving to the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in December of 2009. Kathryn loved doing ceramics and had a ceramic shop in the garage behind the family home in Glendive. Kathryn was a member of the Catholic Daughters, the Far and Near Homemakers Club and Women of the Moose. She was preceded in death by her parents; Joseph and Jannet Wyse, her husband George E. Haggerty in 1984, four brothers, three sisters and one granddaughter; Amy Kamerman, one son-in-law Raymond Sell, and great grandson Jesse Haggerty. Survivors include her son; Joe (Kathy) Haggerty of Nye, Montana, daughter, Marjorie Sell of Glendive, six grandchildren; eighteen great grandchildren; two great great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and newphews.
