Kathryn C. "Babe" Dietz, age 93, of Shepherd, Montana, formerly of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, March 18, 2007 in Billings, Montana. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 A.M., Saturday, March 24, 2007 at the Glendive Alliance Church in Glendive with Pastor Joel Arndt officiating. She taught harmony to her children and had them singing at an early age. You never knew if she would be singing soprano, alto, tenor or bass in any given song. Not only did she instill in us her love for music, but also taught integrity and ethical values. Her wit and sense of humor will be sorely missed. She had an innate ability to make people laugh. Babe was a member of the Christian Women's Club. She was preceded in death by her daughter, Gail Greenfield in 1990 and all of her siblings.
