November 18, 1915 - April 1, 2010

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Kathryn Hostetler, age 94, formerly of Bloomfield, Montana, passed away on Saturday, March 27, 2010 at the Robison Care Center in Glendive. In 1946, they moved to Ohio, two years later in 1948 they moved to Bloomfield. They lived, farmed and raised their family in Bloomfield, moving to Glendive in 1993. Kathryn moved into the Robison Care Center in 2009. Kathryn enjoyed singing, playing the harmonica, reading, visiting and writing letters. She memorized verses and entire chapters of the bible. Her faith in God was strong and unwavering. She

believed that prayer changes all things and lived her life accordingly. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Lloyd; her sister, Barbara Chupp and three brothers, Dave, Rufus and a baby brother.
