December 20, 1919 - June 12, 2008

Kathryn L. Paulson, age 88, long time resident of Glendive, passed away on Friday, June 6, 2008 peacefully in her sleep at home of natural causes. A Memorial Service will be held at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, June 12, 2008 at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Glendive with Brother Guy Pontoriero officiating. Kathryn was born on December 20, 1919 in Conrad, Montana, the daughter of Henry and Leva (Cowan) Lane. Kathryn's mother re-married when Kathryn was a child and her step-father, Herbert Robinson, played a significant role in Kathryn's upbringing. She was raised and educated in Conrad, graduating from Conrad High School in 1937. She married Vern G. Paulson on January 20, 1942 in Billings and moved to Glendive soon after. Vern opened an accounting, real estate and insurance business. During the next 60 years of living in Glendive, Kay was a mother, wife, meticulous house keeper, gardener and neighbor. She attended classes at Dawson Community College, drove a purple 1965 Ford and had a fine sense of humor and was a poor player of Bridge. She was an avid tennis fan, dog lover, bird watcher and an advocate of all things "fair". She would always say "Okay, I'll do it myself". Kay was preceded in death by her two sisters, Ellen Mae Geft and Virginia Yunck and a half brother, Herbert Robinson II and her husband of 52 years, Vern G. Paulson. Survivors include her sons, Marty Paulson and his wife Linda of Lewistown, Montana, Glenn Paulson and his

wife Sandy of Shepherd, Montana and Curt Paulson of Bozeman, Montana;
