Kayla Marie Tandy passed away Tuesday June 28, 2022.

Kayla was considered to be a bright light by all. Her undeniable charisma and caring nature made everyone love being around her. Her laugh was contagious, and her energy radiated in an indescribable way. Her fearlessness, determination, and ability to connect with people allowed her to excel in new situations and make new friends wherever she went.

Kayla was born February 27, 1998 in Sleepy Hollow, NY and raised in Peekskill and Montrose, New York.

She was living in Hays, Montana where she was working with Montana State University Extension at Fort Belknap Reservation managing the community gardens and assisting the 4-H program.

Kayla was a 2016 Hendrick Hudson High School Graduate where she was a captain of the varsity field hockey team and member of the national honor society. She was also known for her humor and riding around in her gold Ford Ranger.

Kayla was a 2019 graduate from the State University of New York at Geneseo. Her intensive course load allowed her to earn a Bachelors in Economics with Suma Cum Laude honors in three years.

After college, Kayla spent two years as a Jesuit Volunteer Corps. Member

teaching at Mission Grade School in Hays, Montana, where she cared fiercely about her students.

After Mission Grade School, Kayla worked as a Garden Educator at the Kids Unlimited Academy in Medford, Oregon, before returning to her community in Hays for her second summer working for MSU Extension.

She is survived by her parents Claire and Patrick, her brothers Sean and Ryan, her grandparents Dave and Cele Tandy and Patricia Osborn, as well as her many aunts, uncles, cousins, friends, neighbors, and students.
