Keith Arlynn "Mac" McIntyre, age 79, of Glendive, passed away on Thursday, May 5, 2005 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Memorial services will be held at 11:00 A.M., Monday, May 9, 2005 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Howard Schreibeis officiating. He was raised and educated in Glendive. He worked as a crew caller for the Northern Pacific Railroad until entering the U.S. Army Air Corp at the age of 17 and served during World War II. Keith was united in marriage to Bev Curtis on August 8, 1948 in Big Bear Lake, California. After five years in the military, Keith received an honorable discharge from the U.S. Air Force in November 1948. Following his discharge from the military, Keith returned to Glendive where he resumed work for the Northern Pacific Railroad. He was employed by the NPRR for 46 years until his retirement in 1989 as a brakeman. Keith was a member of the Glendive Elks Lodge and the American Legion. He enjoyed baseball and served on the Glendive Babe Ruth Board. He loved animals, kids and particularly enjoyed watching Little League, Babe Ruth and American Legion Baseball. Keith was preceded in death by three brothers and one sister. Keith is survived by his wife, Bev McIntyre, of Glendive; his sons, Rick McIntyre and his wife Sherina of Billings, Montana and Randy McIntyre and his wife Joan of Anaconda, Montana; three grandchildren, Aaron McIntyre and Heather of Lindsay, Montana, Gina Colton
