



Kenneth Roy Brose Sr.

Kenneth Roy Brose Sr. age 85 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Sunday, April 7, 2024 at his home in Glendive. Visitation will be from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Friday, April 12, 2024 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be at 1:00 PM on Saturday, April 13, 2024 at The Church in Glendive with Kyle and Kirk Hinebauch officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Riverview Cemetery in Savage, Montana. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Kenneth was born May 9, 1938 in Savage the third of nine children to his parents Roy and Dorthy (Putnam) Brose. He was raised and educated in Savage graduating from Savage High School with the class of 1956.

Following high school Kenneth worked near Missoula, Montana for a couple of years before he entered the United States Army. He was stationed mainly in Germany before he received his honorable discharge after more than two years of services. After his military service, Kenneth met Diana Nickerson and they were united in marriage on November 23, 1962 in Burns, Oregon and to this union two sons were born. Kenneth worked on a ranch in Oregon before the family moved to California where he continued working on ranches before furthering his education. He earned his bachelor's degree from Fresno State University in 1974 and then began his banking career as an appraiser and loan officer for the next thirty years. Following his retirement, Kenneth and Diana returned to Montana in 2006 where they have operated a hobby ranch ever since.

Kenneth enjoyed writing poetry, bronze sculpting and taking care of his animals and being a cowboy. He was active in his church and was on the Republican Committee. He loved and cherished the time he spent with his grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister, Lyla DeLamere; four brothers, Victor, Duane, Dwight and Dean.

He is survived by his wife, Diana Brose of Glendive; two sons, Kenneth Brose Jr. of Glendive and Joseph Brose of North Carolina; three grandchildren, Sondra Brose of Boise, Idaho, Telisa (Joe) Rios of Salinas, California and Clayton Brose of Oregon; three sisters, Doris Storlie of Billings, Montana, Evelyn Ross of Mustang, Oklahoma and JoAn (Al) Hendrickson of Victor, Montana and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
