Kenneth Arlon Davidson, age 52, of Wibaux, Montana, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, died on Friday, November 14, 2003 in Glendive, Montana. In 1982, Ken moved back to the family farm at Sentinel Butte to raise his family. In 1996, Ken sold insurance and in 1997 he went back to detailing at West Plains in Beach. Ken went to work for Bowman Sales and Service in

1998 where he detailed cars. In 2002, he moved to Glendive, Montana where he detailed cars for American Ford. Ken moved to a ranch north of Wibaux, Montana in 2003 where he resided at the time of his death. Ken was a very special person to many people. He had a wonderful sense of humor. Ken was a very sociable person and had a way of keeping his audience interested in what was being said. He touched many people and was very loved by all his family and friends.
