



Kenneth "Kenny" Edwards

January 4, 1922 - October 6, 2003

Kenneth "Kenny" Edwards, age 81, Glendive, passed away on Thursday, October 2, 2003 at the Robison Care Center in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, October 6, 2003 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor Paul Everett officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Kenny was born on January 4, 1922 in Glendive, Montana, the son of Arthur and Gertrude (Hilton) Edwards. He was raised and educated in the Glendive area and received his early education at Sunrise School in rural Dawson County. Kenny graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1940. He began his farming and ranching life on the 1912 homestead of his father, located in the Pleasantview community. Kenny married Jeanne Leach in January, 1942. He married Shirley Beres in May, 1978. Kenny was preceded in death by his wife Shirley in January, 2001. He was a life member of the Glendive Moose Lodge #949 and a life member of the Glendive Elks Lodge #1324. Kenny served as a supervisor on the Dawson County Soil Conservation District Board and held office in the State Soil Conservation Association. Kenny was involved in politics and served in the Montana House of Representatives in the 37th Legislative Session of 1961. He was a founder of Grain Growers, Inc. cooperative grain elevator and served as its President from 1961 until 1990. Kenny served on the Dawson Community College Board of Trustees from 1973 to 1980. Kenny loved farming and ranching and greatly enjoyed his trip

to Russia in 1976. He also enjoyed his fishing trips to Canada with his friends. Kenny was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Lyle in 1974. Survivors include his daughter, Penny James and her husband Robert of Las Vegas, Nevada; his son, Gary Edwards and his wife Rita of Glendive; three stepsons, Joel Beres and his wife Beth of Louisville, Kentucky, Tim Beres of Turlock, California and Steve Beres of Glendive; seven grandchildren, Todd James, Jeanilyn James, Kristen James and Beau James, Deidre Edwards, Jessica Edwards and Olivia Beres; four great grandchildren; his sister, Ardyce Nentwig and her husband Merton of Glendive.
