Kenneth R. Rathbun, age 50, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, May 7, 2003 at his home in Glendive following a brief battle with cancer. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Saturday, May 10, 2003 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Ken maintained a special relationship with members of the staff as well as the residents he worked with at Eastmont. Ken loved fishing, hunting and golfing with all of his friends and family. He was a great gardener and enjoyed jigsaw puzzles. Ken was a good cook who enjoyed barbecuing. Ken also loved his English Setter "Lucky". Ken was a member of the Montana Public Employee Association for 20 years and

had served as a union representative and was instrumental in contract negotiations. He was a member of the American Legion.
