Early Monday morning, November 21, 2022, Kerry Allen Parker left us to be with Jesus at the age of 73.

A devoted Christian and friend to many, he started life in Glendive, Montana, to Evelyn and Kermit Parker. He graduated high school in Glendive, worked hard, joined the Army, and went on to pursue an extensive education. With multiple titles and degrees, he lived his life compassionately, as an ordained minister, chemical dependency counselor, and National Service Officer for the Department of Veteran's Affairs.

Kerry was a tough man but always focused on helping others with recovery and growth. After spending years fighting and lobbying in Washington DC, he was responsible for getting our veterans recognition and, thus, benefits for post-traumatic stress disorder.

Kerry spent time alone in nature when he could. He lived a big life and it was an honor to know him. He spent his later years driving truck and this gave him time seeing our country that he loved.

We know we will see Kerry again and he will hear the words he longed for, "Well done, my good and faithful servant."
