August 30, 1912 - April 18, 2007

Kora Kempton, age 94, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, April 16, 2007 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. Memorial Services will be held at 2:30 P.M., Wednesday, April 18, 2007 at Grandview Retirement Home in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be at a later date in the Prairie County Cemetery in Terry, Montana. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Kora was born on August 30, 1912 at the ranch in Hodges, Montana, the daughter of John and Hannah (Jensen) Kartevold. She attended Hodges grade school and graduated from Carl Schurz High School in Chicago, Illinois in 1930. Kora was united in marriage to Edmond Kempton on May 21, 1939 in Terry, Montana. Following their marriage, they moved to Plentywood, Montana and later to a ranch in Terry, Montana. Ed was employed by Indian Services and later by the Bureau of Reclamation which involved the family moving to Wolf Point and Poplar, Montana. They then moved to Ephrata, Washington where Kora worked in the courthouse and became involved as a 4-H leader. They moved to Billings, Montana where Kora continued to remain active in 4-H. They later moved to Sacramento, California and Kora volunteered and later became actively employed by the Easter Seal Society. Kora and her husband moved to Oklahoma before retiring to Arizona where they resided until 1999 when they moved to Grandview Retirement Home in Glendive, Montana. She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, and was a life member of the Order of Eastern Star. Kora is survived by her husband, Edmond Kempton of

Glendive; her daughter, Kay Raade and her husband Knut of Winterville, North Carolina; her son, Kenneth Kempton and his wife Joanne of Grass Valley, California; her brother, Obert Kartevold of Glendive; four grandchildren and three great grandchildren; numerous nieces and nephews.
