After they moved to Beach, Jean joined a weekly Pinochle club which she thoroughly enjoyed. Jean was a fantastic cook and always had something homemade when anyone visited. She cooked for many large groups at brandings and other local events. Jean especially loved her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She was always proud of their accomplishments.
