Glendive, Montana: Leah Haas, age 93, passed away on Monday, May 13, 2013 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Leah met her future husband in 1935, Adam Haas and they were united in marriage on November 5, 1935 and to this union, four children were born; Patricia Hansen, Gary (Pat) Haas, Judy (Allan) Broeder and Arlene (Danny) Kapfer. Following their marriage, Leah and Adam moved to Nebraska where they worked on a farm until 1941 when they moved back to Montana to farm. As a couple, Leah and Adam purchased a farm in 1943 on Buffalo Rapids where they raised their children. They lived on this farm for sixty years until Adam passed away in June of 2000 and two years later Leah moved to Forest Park in Glendive. Leah and Adam were married for almost sixty-five years. In 1982, they retired from farm work but continued to grow large gardens; growing lots of sweet corn, watermelon and cantaloupe. Leah had a green thumb and raised a lot of

beautiful flowers. She was preceded in death by her parents, Henry and Kathryn Haffner; husband, Adam; sisters, Mollie Miller, Lydia Gable and Emma Rein; brother, George Haffner; son-in-law, Dick Hansen and great-granddaughter, Samara Wilcox.
