



## LeMar Martin Schock

March 14, 1940 - January 7, 2022

LeMar Martin Schock, age 81, passed away Friday, January 7, 2022, at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, February 5, 2022, at 2:00 pm at Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Celebrant Heidi Carney officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

LeMar was born in Kulm, North Dakota on March 14, 1940, the eldest of three boys to Enoch (Shorty) and Edna Schock. The family moved to Glendive, Montana and LeMar graduated from Dawson County High School in 1958. Following high school, LeMar graduated from barber college and eventually returned to Glendive. He purchased a barber shop on main street where he barbered for 45 years. After coming back to Glendive, he met and married Edna Jandt. They had five children. Summer weekends were usually spent with the whole family and three dogs, floating the Yellowstone River between Fallon and Glendive in a handcrafted pontoon boat. During the winters, weekends were spent hunting and ice fishing enough to keep all the freezers full. Sausage and wine making was always a family tradition. He had a passion for the outdoors and loved fishing, bow hunting, bird hunting which provided endless stories.

Years after the end of his marriage to Edna, he was reunited with a longtime friend and classmate, Marlene Bryant. They were united in marriage in 2000. The two have enjoyed retirement together spending time with family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his brother Larry Schock. LeMar is survived by his wife, Marlene, his brother, Dennis (Dorothy) Schock; his five children Lea (Terry) Ringen, Shawn (Chelsea Thomsen) Schock, Mike (Amy) Schock, Amy (Joel) Anderson and Ty (Lesa) Schock; his 12 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.
