Lenora was a lifetime member of the Assembly of God Church and was a founding member of the Calvary Temple Assembly of God church in Wibaux. She had many gifts and talents, she was an excellent seamstress, she loved working in her garden, canning, crocheting and refinishing furniture. Lenore could do anything she set her mind to.
