Leo R. Doll, 92, of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Wednesday, April 1, 2026, at the Heritage in Glendive with his family by his side. Visitation will be held Monday, April 6, 2026, from 5 PM - 7 PM, Monday, April 6, 2026, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with a Rosary and Vigil Service to follow at 7 PM. He is preceded in death by his parents, Roy and Annie; his siblings Mary, Barbara, Steve, and Leonard.

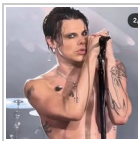
