



Leonard Dschaak

March 16, 1936 - March 31, 2008

Leonard Dschaak, age 72, of Glendive, passed away on Thursday, March 27, 2008 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be on Sunday, March 30, 2008 from 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. and from 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Visitation will be on Monday, March 31, 2008 from 10:00 A.M. until Noon and one hour prior to service time at the Zion Lutheran Church in Fairview, Montana. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Monday, March 31, 2008 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Fairview, Montana with Pastor Ron Martin-Dent officiating. Leonard was born on March 16, 1936 in Fairview, Montana, the son of Heinrich and Freida (Beyl) Dschaak, one of eleven children. He was raised and educated in the Fairview area until he joined the United States Army in 1953. After his honorable discharge in 1955 he returned to Fairview where he worked at the Standard Station. Leonard married Louise Fletcher on July 6, 1956 in Forsyth, Montana. Later that same year, they moved to California where Leonard did various jobs before going to work for North American Aviation. Together they had three children, Lennie, Larry and Laurie. In 1964, they returned to Fairview and were later divorced. Leonard met Linda Cowee in Glendive while he was home on vacation from Washington where he was employed by Boeing Aircraft Company. They were married in 1967. Leonard was asked to return to his old job at North American Rockwell in

Anaheim, California. There they made their home for 2 ½ years before Leonard's longing for Montana led him to Wibaux, Montana in 1977. There they raised three boys, Todd, Tim and Mike, and built their dream home. Commuting back and forth to Glendive, Leonard worked for the Burlington Northern Railroad for at least 30 years. He then moved to Glendive closer to his retirement and lived out the rest of his years. He was preceded in death by his parents, a sister, Freida, and his son, Timothy in January of 2008. Survivors include his children, Lenny Dschaak of Fairview, Larry (Alice) Dschaak of Willis, Texas, Laurie (Jeff) Ketterling of Fairview, Todd (Sheila) Dschaak of Glendive and Mike (Misty) Dschaak of Dickinson, North Dakota; daughter-in-law, Janell of Wibaux; numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren, brothers and sisters.
