Larry and Arlene crafted a life centered around their farm where Larry found his true passion. A pillar of his community, Larry was actively involved in Our Savior Lutheran Church, Zion Lutheran Church, the school board, booster club, Buffalo Rapids Water Board, Holly Sugar Board, and Farm Credit Services Board. He also dedicated time to the sales yard on Fridays, showcasing his dedication and work ethic. Larry's interests spanned sports, travel, quality time with his grandchildren, and indulging in ice cream after a hard day's work. 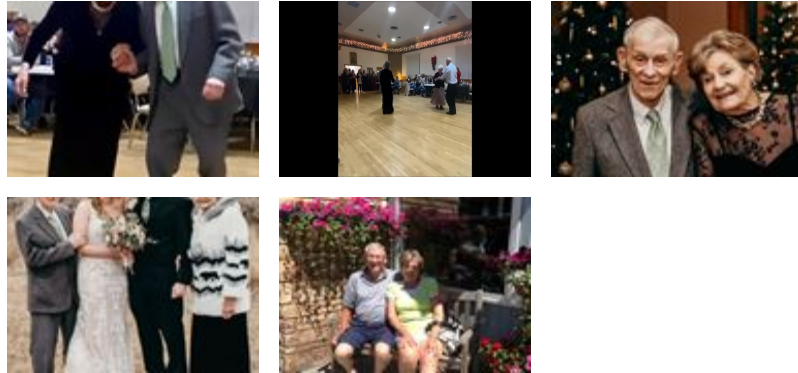
