



## Leonard Streit

December 5, 1911 - May 8, 2008

Mr. Leonard Streit, age 96, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Saturday, May 3, 2008, at St. Luke's Nursing Home in Dickinson, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach and from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva, North Dakota, on Wednesday, May 7, 2008. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, May 7, 2008, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, May 8, 2008, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva with Rev. Fr. David Richter officiating. Rite of Committal will be in St. Mary's Cemetery in Golva. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Leonard was born on December 5, 1911, in Bullion Township, North Dakota, the son of Jacob and Anna (Niehaus) Streit. He was educated in the Garner and Bullion schools. In the 1920s, Leonard worked for a rancher near Bullion Butte. During the 1930s, Leonard worked at the C.P. Parker ranch in Minot, North Dakota, taking care of 100 head of buffalo. In 1956, he was employed on the Pine Unit Gas Line out of Baker, Montana. Leonard was united in marriage to Margaret Howard in 1940. The couple bought the Andrew Peterson place and farmed and ranched on it until returning to Beach in 1990. In addition to farming and ranching, Leonard drilled wells and moved buildings. He served on the Garner Township board, the school board, and the telephone board. In his spare time, Leonard liked to play cards and horseshoes, to dance, and to read Louis L'Amour westerns. Leonard was

preceded in death by his parents, 4 brothers, 1 sister, 1 infant daughter, and 1 infant grandson. Leonard is survived by his wife, Margaret of Beach; his four sons, Larry Streitz of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota; Wayne Streitz and his wife Pat of Columbus, Montana; David Streitz and his wife Mary Kay of Deer Lodge, Montana; Gerald Streitz and his wife Tracey of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota; his daughter, Sheryl Fischer and her husband Jack of Golva, North Dakota; his grandchildren, Brian Fischer; Susan Riggs; Jacob Streitz; Josie Streitz; and Katie Streitz; his 5 great-grandchildren, Sydnee Streitz; Axel Streitz; Morgan Riggs; and Nathan and Casey Fischer; and his sister, Cecelia Watembach of Wibaux, Montana.
