Lester F. Ollerman, 77, of Glendive went to be with his Lord and Savior on Saturday, November 26, 2005 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, November 29, 2005 at 2:00 P.M. at the Evangelical Church of North America in Glendive. Interment with military honors will be in Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive.

Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with the arrangements. Lester was born on October 14, 1928 in Glendive, Montana the son of Ferdinand Julius and Almira May (Trulock) Oellerman. He attended rural Dawson County schools and Dawson County High School in Glendive, graduating with the class of 1948. Lester was drafted into the United States Army in 1950 and served in the Occupation Army of Japan and the Korean War. He returned home in 1952 and was honorably discharged from the active reserve as a Sgt., in May of 1956. Lester married Bonita J. McDonald on November 22, 1952 in Glendive. Lester started to work for the United States Post Office in Glendive in December of 1953. He retired from postal service as an Assistant Post Master in November of 1983. Following Lester's retirement from the Post Office he served on the Glendive City Council for a two year term and was later elected Mayor of Glendive, a position that he held for two consecutive four year terms. Lester was involved in the Glendive Public Employees Credit Union, having served as the Treasurer Manager, President, board member, and Chairman of the Supervisory Committee. Lester was active in volunteer service at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive

and had served as President of the Veterans Committee and Foundation. He was past Co-Chair of the Bell Street Bridge Committee. As a member of the local Gideons he served as an officer. Numerous years were spent in church activities, as a Sunday School teacher, serving as Superintendent and various other offices in the Evangelical Church. After retirement, Lester and Bonita enjoyed traveling, their family, grandchildren and great grandchildren. Lester was preceded in death by his parents, one brother George Oellerman and a great granddaughter Corin Ollerman. Survivors include his wife, Bonita of Glendive, one son, Allen Ollerman and his wife Joleen of Glendive, one daughter, Gloria Brown and her husband Tim of Glendive, four sisters; Dorothy Oellerman of Glendive, Harriet Ward and her husband Charles of Billings, Montana, Marie Unruh and her husband Leslie of Bloomfield, Montana, Marjorie Sutton and her husband Eugene of Lynnwood, Washington; seven grandchildren; Michael and his wife Brandi, Corey (Mandi), Tricia, Aarin, Tarin, Tiffany and Jared, seven great grandchildren; Haiden, Deon and Camri, Lauryn, Maximus, Mason, and Lillian, numerous nieces and nephews.
