January 24, 1913 - October 28, 2004

Lillian Mae LaBelle, age 91, died on Sunday, October 24, 2004 at the Fallon Medical Complex in Baker, Montana. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, October 27, 2004 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, October 28, 2004 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux with Father Denis Fournier officiating. Lillian was born on January 24, 1913 at the family home near Glendive, Montana, the daughter of Chauncey and Clara (Carpenter) Bacon. She was raised and educated in Glendive schools, graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1932. Lillian married Edwin LaBelle on October 9, 1936 in Glendive. They made their home on a ranch on Cedar Creek near Wibaux, Montana until moving to Glendive and in 1950 to Wibaux where Lillian resided until the time of her death. Lillian worked at the Wibaux County Courthouse, as a secretary at the Wibaux County High School and at the City of Wibaux Water Department until her retirement at the age of 82. She had helped with the baking at the Palace Café for the past 25 years. Lillian always helped those in need, especially her family members. She loved reading, country music and was always very proud of her family. She had always been very active in St. Peter's Catholic Church. Lillian was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Edwin in 1979; her son, Larry in 1990; her daughter, Cathy in 2001; two brothers and two sisters. Survivors include two daughters, Jeannie Hart
