GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Lillian M. Walker, age 92, passed away on Sunday, October 10, 2010 at the Heritage on Merrill Assisted Living. She attended eight grades at the Bloomfield School. As a young girl, she enjoyed dancing, ice skating and playing cards. Lillian married Judd Walker on September 15, 1939, in Glendive. Upon the death of her mother, Lillian and Judd became guardians for Lillian's four younger siblings. The two younger sisters lived with them. Four children were born into the Walker family, Ilene, Don, Carol and Judy. Lillian was active as a 4-H leader for numerous years, before and after her marriage. She was a member of the Moose, the Sons of Norway, the Good Sam Club and the Bloomfield area Birthday Club. She was a skilled and avid flower and vegetable gardener. She enjoyed traveling with Judd to State and National REA meetings. She was known for her excellent cooking and baking. It was not uncommon for Lillian to invite an unexpected guest to join

the family for a meal. In addition to helping Judd with the farming, she delivered milk and cream to Bloomfield families and cream and eggs in Glendive. She also raised and sold turkeys for the holidays. This in turn helped fulfill her dream of a higher education for her four children. Lillian was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Judd in August, 2009; her nine brothers, Joe, Albert, Leonard, Gust, Jim, Charles, Alvin, Frank and Rudy and her granddaughter, Dorraine Latka.
