Lillie “Tillie” Maxine Hinton passed away on Monday, February 2, 2026, at the age of 93, at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive, Montana. Lillie had 15 siblings. She was third to the youngest and the last one to pass away. She was preceded in death by her oldest son Thomas Lee, and her
