



Linda Kay Eaton

October 17, 1944 - October 3, 2024

Linda K. Eaton, age 79 of Terry, Montana, passed away on Thursday, October 3, 2024 at her home. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM with a Family and Friends service at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 AM on Thursday, October 10, 2024 at the Evangelical Church in Glendive with Pastor David Steinbron officiating. Interment will follow in the Union Cemetery south of Lindsay, Montana. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Linda was born October 17, 1944, in Glendive, Montana. She grew up on the family farm east of Bloomfield as the second oldest of nine children born to George and June (Grigsby) Zody. Linda attended West Pleasant Plains elementary in Bloomfield, often remembering her dad breaking trail through the snow for her and her siblings, as it was a mile-long walk. She also cherished memories of summer evening softball games with neighborhood kids in the Bloomfield community.

Linda later attended high school in Glendive, spending weekdays with her grandparents and returning home on weekends. After high school, she earned a degree in Elementary Education from Dickinson State College and taught in rural schools for five years. It was during this time she met the love of her life, Elner Eaton, when he dropped his sisters off at Lindsay school. Linda and Elner married in 1970, and she became a full-time wife and mother. Once her children were grown, Linda returned to education as a substitute teacher at

the Lindsay school, quickly becoming a favorite among students.

Linda won Homemaker of the Year at the Prairie County Fair three times, a testament to her exceptional skills and dedication. She was a masterful baker, always sharing homemade treats with her guests, and her embroidery and cross-stitch were so precise that a judge once thought her work was machine-made. Linda's warmth, talent, and generosity touched the lives of everyone who knew her.

Linda accepted the Lord as her Savior as a young child while attending South Valley rural church and was later baptized in the creek on the family farm.

Linda and Elner were long-time members of the Evangelical Church, where she and Pat Skillestad taught children's Sunday School for 30 years.

One of Linda's favorite activities was volunteering at The Attic. Over the eight years she worked there, she formed many lasting friendships and looked forward to it each week.

Linda was preceded in death by her husband, Elner; parents, George and June Zody; and brother, Larry Zody. She is survived by her children, Brad (Holly), and Heather (Aaron) McIntyre; four grandchildren, Abby Eaton, Alex Eaton, Hayden and Jett McIntyre; brothers, Steven and Mark (Anita) Zody; sisters, Rhonda Bornholtz, Kathy (Bill) LaFond, Sheryl (Roy) Johnson, Valerie (Jim) Maus, Susan (Bill) Edwards; and numerous nieces and nephews.
